9. Women's Aerosol Train report

Hanna Vehkamäki and Ilona Riipinen from Helsinki have given two-day intensive courses in atmospheric particle formation around Europe. The aim of the course is to give attendees a good overview of the state-of-the-art in the field of atmospheric nucleation studies and what research questions still remain to be answered. Additional aim of the course is to promote gender equality by giving positive examples of female scientists. To keep in line with the climate change-related motivation of their research, they travel around Europe by train and ferry. Women's aerosol train has been made possible by the funding from Vilho, Kalle and Yrjö Väisälä foundation.
