NOSA Annual Meeting 2007 on Thursday, November 8th 2007, in Helsingør, Denmark

The NOSA Annual Meeting 2007 was opened by the NOSA president Mattias Hallquist at 17.30 o'clock. 23 NOSA members were present.

The NOSA president Mattias Hallquist was chosen to head the meeting.

Andreas Massling was decided to be the secretary of the NOSA Annual Meeting 2007.

Thomas Schneider was decided to approve the minutes taken by Andreas Massling.

After this election Erik Swietlicki gave a short report about the European Aerosol Assembly (EAA) and the International Aerosol Research Assembly (IARA) board meetings in 2007 (for details please see the presentation of Erik Swietlicki).

The NOSA Aerosol Symposium 2008 was decided to be held in Norway by the NOSA Annual Meeting 2006. Karl Espen Yttri from the Norwegian Institute for Air Research in Kjeller, Norway, gave a short report about the status. He said that he has been talking to the managers of his institute and got the o.k. for preparing the symposium. He will be the representative of the Norwegian Institute of Air Research and head the local organizing committee of the NOSA Aerosol Symposium 2008. The exact location of where the NOSA symposium 2008 will be held is not decided yet. It was suggested to have the meeting at the 6th and 7th of November 2008 +/- 1 week.

In addition, it was suggested that the NOSA Aerosol Symposium 2009 could be held at the Lund University. Erik Swietlicki and Joakim Pagels as representatives from the Lund University in Sweden also agreed on this suggestion.

It was suggested that there will be no separate NOSA Aerosol Symposium 2010 in the Nordic Countries as the International Aerosol Conference (IAC) will be held in Helsinki, Finland, in 2010 and that the NOSA Annual Meeting 2010 will be held during this IAC.

The NOSA Annual Meeting 2007 was closed by the NOSA president Mattias Hallquist at 18.20 o'clock.
